Applications are invited for admissions into the above programs offered by Chaitanya (Deemed to be University)

Those who got qualified and possess a valid score in JEE, EAMCET, NEET and other State Entrance Tests recognized by UGC are also eligible to take admission in our Chaitanya (Deemed to be University).

Chaitanya (Deemed to be University) reserves the right to admit or Cancel Admission of candidate into any program.

II. Entrance Test and Admission Procedure

- The University shall conduct an Entrance Test for admission to a program only when the number of eligible applications received exceeds the sanctioned intake of the respective program.
- In cases where the number of eligible applications received is equal to or less than the sanctioned intake, admissions shall be granted directly based on eligibility criteria and merit, without conducting an Entrance Test.
- The merit list, where applicable, shall be prepared in accordance with the eligibility conditions, reservation policy, and applicable statutory regulations of the University and relevant regulatory bodies.

III. How to apply

- Candidates have to submit their applications online at www.chaitanya.edu.in or offline at the Office of the Dean, Admissions on or before **April 08, 2026**,
- By **Rs. 400/-** (Rupees Four Hundred only) **without a late fee.**
- The Office of the Dean, Admissions will not take any responsibility for the non-receipt of applications in time.
- Candidates have to submit separate application forms for each program.

IV. How to take the entrance test

The test will be conducted three times. The candidate has the liberty to take both the tests and the better score will be taken into consideration.

The candidates can appear for the Entrance Test through our At-Home-Exam[®]. They can take the test from their home. They require a Laptop or a TAB with a camera.

While appearing for the Entrance Test, the candidate should not leave the Laptop or TAB until the examination is completed. There should not be any noise or disturbance during the examination. Candidates should not turn their heads left or right or move back from the Laptop or TAB screen. If they do so, the system automatically stops.

Admission shall be based on the marks secured in the Chaitanya Entrance Test (CET-2026) or JEE or EAMCET or NEET subject to the fulfillment of the eligibility criteria and the rules of reservation.

2. Transfer and Conduct Certificates from the Institution where the candidate last studied.
3. SSC Marks Sheet
4. Last 7 years Bonafide Certificate
5. Integrated Community Certificate issued by the competent authority in case of OBC/SC/ST candidates if applicable.
6. Economically Weaker Section (EWS) certificate if applicable
7. Medical Certificate from not below the rank of a Civil Surgeon in case of Differently abled candidates
